Instructor Course Summary

This nine-hour sanitation instructor/proctor course (includes 60-minute exam) is designed to assist Family and Consumer Science teachers in becoming a Food Safety Instructor/Proctor through ServSafe. Topics to be covered include time-temperature abuse, food borne illness outbreaks, relationship between personal hygiene and food safety, methods for preventing food contamination, the flow of food from purchasing to serving, procedures for cleaning and sanitizing, facility management, and sanitation management through the food code. Once the FCS teacher passes the ServSafe Food Protection Manager Certification, then he/she can be certified to teach the ServSafe curriculum and administer the ServSafe Food Handler and Manager's Certification exams. This will allow his/her students to earn the National ServSafe Food Handler Certification and the National ServSafe Manager's Certification. Cost \$350.
